a) the number of applications received and processed by the Department claiming subsidy under Kamdhenu Scheme;	<p>Madam, During the year 2021-22, The Department has received 319 numbers of applications under the Kamdhenu Scheme for release of subsidy after purchase of milch animals. 300 numbers of applications were processed for release of subsidy.</p> <p>19 numbers of applications of new beneficiaries were processed but subsidy could not be released in that financial year as Model code of Conduct was in force. However, presently all are released.</p> <p>287 applications were received for sanctioning of milch animals out of which 247 applications were sanctioned. Remaining applicants were informed about their shortfalls.</p> <p>In Current year 2022-23 (up to 30/06/2022), 68 applications received for release of subsidy. All beneficiaries released subsidy.</p> <p>Total 56 nos. of applications are received for sanctioning of the proposal and 33 nos. of applications have been sanctioned. Remaining applications are under process.</p>
b) the time taken to credit the amount of subsidy in the account of the beneficiaries; and	The time generally taken to credit the amount of subsidy in to the account of beneficiaries is 3 months after the purchase of the milch animals and after submission all requisite documents.
c) whether the Government intends to fix timeline to release the said subsidy to the beneficiaries?	Yes; Madam. The Government intends to fix the timeline for release of the said subsidy after the purchase of the milch animals.
